Badan Meteorologi, Klimatologi dan Geofisika BMKG (Meteorology, Climatology & Geophysics Agency) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Enhancing the IT capacity and computational infrastructure for disaster mitigation with a specific focus on fortifying geophysical modelling (tsunami) and numerical weather prediction models. The comprehensive project scope encompasses the planning and acquisition of essential components, including High-Performance Computers, Virtualization Servers, Storage, Geoscience Ecosystem, Services/Applications, and Infrastructure Support. The augmentation of these systems is slated for implementation at the BMKG Headquarters in Jakarta and the BMKG Regional Office III in Bali.

Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018 as indicated in Loan Agreement, and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
