1. Pelamar mencermati informasi terkait pelatihan dan **berkonsultasi** untuk mendapat persetujuan dari Kepala UPT/ Kepala BBMKG/ Kepala Pusat/ Ketua STMKG. Pelatihan yang akan diikuti harus sesuai dengan tugas pokok dan fungsi unit kerja dan *job desk* peserta. Untuk keberhasilan dan manfaat optimal dalam mengikuti pelatihan, diperlukan komitmen peserta untuk mengikuti dengan sungguh-sungguh pelatihan dimaksud;
2. Pelamar yang sudah mendapatkan persetujuan atasan, ditunjukkan dengan surat pernyataan persetujuan/ izin dari pimpinan (*endorsement letter*) untuk mengikuti pelatihan dan selanjutnya melakukan **pendaftaran mandiri secara daring**;
3. Australia Awards in Indonesia is seeking applications for the **Climate Finance** Short Course. The course explores the importance of climate finance to support Indonesia's green economy transition and compares the latest policies and initiatives to marshal and attract climate finance from different innovative funding sources to support Indonesia's climate and development objectives. The course also aims to strengthen the partnership between Indonesia and Australia by sharing case studies on navigating the path to net zero under the Australia-Indonesia Joint Statement on Cooperation on the Green Economy and Energy Transition.

The course includes a **2-week course in Australia (subject to COVID-19)** and two 3-day online or face-to-face workshops in Indonesia. The course is offered to 25 participants and it is targeted to Indonesian ministries, provincial governments, NGOs, research institutes and think tanks.

Learning objectives

- Share experiences and best practices on policies and initiatives to strengthen climate finance (including current and planned policies in Indonesia, Australia and globally) to fund mitigation and adaptation activities
- Map and scope the stakeholders that provide climate finance and influence the climate finance sector in Indonesia, Australia and elsewhere relevant
- Explore latest innovations and future directions in climate finance including funding sources, technologies, use of funds, Indonesia's comparative advantage for attracting investments compared to other South-East Asian countries
- Discuss the roles and responsibilities of different GoI agencies to support Indonesia's climate finance ambition – how GoI agencies use the regulatory environment to encourage climate finance from the private sector, both domestically and internationally; and how other government policies and instruments (taxes, duties, excises and other levies and subsidies) can also be used to drive green industrial and sectoral transformation
- Develop action plans to identify new climate finance sources and/or improve existing climate finance arrangements to help achieve national targets
- Build networks with Australian institutions, public and private and experts for partnerships and future collaboration on case studies of Australia's experience and strengthen networks between participating agencies (incl. benchmark Australian inter-agency collaboration and coordination)

To apply for this course, you must be:

- Government of Indonesia representative (Staff at Echelon II level) with a minimum of 3-year experience in a relevant role from the following Indonesian Government Ministries:
 - i. Ministry of Finance
 - ii. Ministry of Environment and Forestry
 - iii. Ministry of National Development Planning (Bappenas)
 - iv. Ministry of Agriculture
 - v. Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources
 - vi. Ministry of Transportation
 - vii. Ministry of Industry
 - viii. Ministry of Public Works and Human Settlements
 - ix. Ministry of Agrarian and Spatial Planning
 - x. Ministry of Home Affairs
 - xi. Central Bureau of Statistics
 - xii. Coordinating Ministry for Maritime and Investment
 - xiii. Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs (oversees BPDH/the Environmental Fund Agency)
 - xiv. BMKG
 - xv. BNPB
- Sub-national (provincial governments) - Particularly resource-rich provinces such as East Kalimantan (hosting FCPF's REDD+ initiative), North Kalimantan (green industry complex), Central Kalimantan (peatland pilots, food estate), Jambi (BioCarbon Fund, mangrove), Riau (oil palm, mangrove), Papua and West Papua
- Other GOI agencies
- A representative from Civil Society Organisations, research institutes or think-tanks
- Endorsed by current manager/supervisor
- Diploma (D3) qualification or higher
- Committed to preparing and implementing an Award Project, a small group development project as part of the course

Applicants are expected to have professional working proficiency in English. The applicants' English language competency is part of the selection process. The course will be delivered in English.

This is a fully funded short course. Course fee, airfares, accommodation, per diem and local transport will be covered by Australia Awards in Indonesia.
