Conclusion

- Identify activities, instrument, research periods, recent status research proposal, location, and institution partner.
- Observation in the eastern Indonesia still sparse and BMKG didn't have plan to add more observation so far
- Each participant should complete their MoU with institutional partners before starting research in Indonesia.
